Details of the Final Round: It is called "1-minute Impromptu Response" to a question you will be received from a committee. The questions are various about anything. You are responsible for providing one-minute talk to best answer that question.

Criteria for the second and final rounds:

- Content 20 marks

(Out of the box thinking, conviction, conciseness, etc.)

- Delivery 20 marks

(Body language, presentation, etc.)

- Speech organisation 10 marks

(Idea organization, introduction and conclusion, etc.)

- Voice 10 marks

(Speak clearly, not read, etc.)

- Question-Response 10 marks

(for the Final round)
